Sanitarian advisory board.

(A) The director of health shall appoint individuals to the advisory board, created pursuant to section 4736.02 of the Revised Code. The advisory board:

- (1) Shall advise the director of health regarding the registration of sanitarians in training and registered sanitarians;
- (2) Shall advise the director of health regarding the continuing education requirements for sanitarians in training and registered sanitarians;
- (3) Shall administer examinations prescribed by section 4736.09 of the Revised Code;
- (4) Shall advise the director of health on the educational requirements required to hold registration as a sanitarian in training or registered sanitarian;
- (5) May establish work groups to address specific issues related to the registration of sanitarians in training and registered sanitarians; and
- (6) May advise the director of health on any other matters regarding the regulation of sanitarians in training or registered sanitarians for which he requires assistance.

(B) Any member of the sanitarian advisory board shall be a registered sanitarian who meets the education and experience requirements of section 4736.08 of the Revised Code.

(C) Pursuant to section 4736.02 of the Revised Code, the director of health, with the advice and consent of the Senate, will appoint seven members to serve in an advisory capacity. The term of service for each member will be for a period of three years and will expire on December 31 of the third year of the term. Members may be reappointed a maximum of three times.

- (1) At least one and not more than two members shall be employees of a general health district;
- (2) At least one and not more than two shall be employees of a city health district;
- (3) At least one and not more than two shall be employed in private industry;
- (4) Not more than one member may be employed by a university; and
- (5) Not more than one member may be employed by an agency or department of the state.

(D) Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner provided for original appointments. Any individuals appointed to fill a vacancy prior to the expiration of the term for which

the individual's predecessor was appointed shall serve for the remainder of that term. The individual appointed to fill the vacancy will be eligible for three additional terms as the vacancy will not be considered their first term on the advisory board.

(E) Individuals appointed to serve on the advisory board shall not be reimbursed for expenses.
